









## **Ground Regulations**

Notice: Entry to Mangata Pay UK Stadium Meadow Park is expressly subject to acceptance by the visitor of these Ground Regulations and the rules and regulations of FIFA, UEFA, The FA, The Premier League, The Football League and The Football Conference in respect of the relevant competition. The Ground Regulations incorporate the Club's Customer Charter (If Any), Entry to the ground shall constitute acceptance.

"Ground" means Mangata Pay UK Stadium Meadow Park and all locations owned, occupied or utilised by Boreham Wood Football Club.

"Club" means Boreham Wood Football Club

"Match" means any association football match taking place at the Ground

- 1. Permission to enter or to remain within the Ground (notwithstanding possession of any ticket) is at the absolute discretion of the Club, Police or Authorised Steward. On no account will admission be granted to a person who is the subject of a current banning order.
- 2. The Club excludes to the maximum extent permitted by law any liability for loss, injury or damage to persons/property in or around the Ground.
- 3. No guarantees can be given by the Club that a Match will take place at a particular time or on a particular date and the Club reserves the right to reschedule the Match without notice and without any liability whatsoever.
- 4. In the event of postponement or abandonment of the Match(If Any) will be made in accordance with the Club's Customer Charter. The Club will have no further liability whatsoever, including (but not limited to) any indirect or consequential loss or damage, such as (but not limited to) loss of enjoyment or travel costs.
- 5. All persons seeking entrance to the Ground acknowledge the Club's right to search them and to refuse entry or to eject from the Ground if any person refuses to submit to a search.
- 6. The following articles must not be bought within the Ground, knives, fireworks, smoke flares, air-horns, flares, weapons, dangerous or hazardous items, laser devices, glass bottles, cans, poles, aerosols or any article that might be used as a weapon to compromise public safety. Any person in possession of such items, will be refused entry and/or ejected from the Ground.

- 7. To further, any person must not bring any sponsorship, promotional or marketing materials into the Ground, save in respect of official club merchandise and/or football related clothing worn in good faith nor may you offer (either free or for sale) any goods (including literature) of any nature without the express written approval of Stadium/Senior Management.
- 8. The use of threatening behaviour, foul or abusive language is strictly forbidden and will result in arrest and/or ejection from the Ground. The Club may impose a ban for one or more Matches.
  - 8.1 Racial, homophobic, transphobic or other discriminatory abuse, chanting or harassment is strictly forbidden and will result in arrest and/or ejection from the Ground. The Club may impose a ban for one or more Matches.
  - 8.2 The following acts are offences under the Football (Offences) Act 1991
    - 8.2.1 The throwing of any object within the Ground without authority/excuse
    - 8.2.2 The chanting of anything of an indecent or racialist nature.
    - 8.2.3 The entry onto the playing/technical area or any area to which spectators are not generally admitted without authority/excuse.

## Conviction may result in a Banning Order being issued

- 9. All persons entering the Ground may only occupy the area allocated to them by their ticket and must not move from any one part of the Ground to another without the express permission or instruction of any Steward, Police Officer or Club Official.
- 10. Nobody may stand in any seating area that purposely blocks other spectators' views or jeopardises safety whilst play is in progress. Persistent standing in seated areas whilst play is in progress is strictly forbidden and may result in ejection from the Ground.
- 11. The obstruction of gangways, access ways, exits and entrances, stairways and like places is strictly forbidden. Nobody entering the ground shall be permitted to climb any structures within the Ground.
- 12. Roofed stands/terraces in the stadium are smoke/vape free. Smoking and Vaping is not permitted inside these areas.
- 13. Mobile telephones are permitted within the Ground, provided that they are used for personal and private use only.
- 14. Under the Sporting Events (Control of Alcohol etc) Act 1985, the following are offences for which a person can be arrested by a Police Officer and conviction could result in a Banning order being issued.
  - 14.1 Attempting to enter the Ground whilst intoxicated
  - 14.2 Being in possession of any intoxicating liquid, bottle, can or other portable container which could cause damage or personal injury, when entering the Ground or in a public area of the Ground from which the event can be directly viewed
  - 14.3 Attempting to enter the Ground whilst under the influence of any class drugs



- 15. Any individual who has entered any part of the Ground designated for the use of any group of supporters to which they do not belong may be ejected from the Ground for the purposes of their own safety or for any other reason.
- 16. No person (other than someone who holds an appropriate licence) may bring into Ground any equipment, which is capable of recording or transmitting any audio, visual or audio-visual material or any information/data in relation to the Match or Ground. Copyright in any unauthorised recording or transmission is assigned (by way of present assignment of future copyright pursuant to section 91 of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988) to the Club.
- 17. No goods (including literature) of any nature may be offered either free or for sale by any person within the Ground without the express written permission from Stadium/Senior Management.
- 18. Tickets are not transferable and may not be offered for sale without the prior written permission of the Club. Any tickets offered for sale may be confiscated by any Steward, Police Officer or Club Official.
- 19. CCTV Cameras are in use around and inside the Ground and the Club may itself pass to the Police or any Footballing Authority, any recordings for use in any proceedings.
- 20. At all times whilst present in the Ground, persons must comply with any and all instructions of any Steward, Police Officer or Club Officials. Failure to comply with any instruction may lead to immediate ejection from the Ground.
- 21. Under no circumstance, any persons under the age of 14 years old will be permitted inside the Ground unaccompanied.
  - 21.1 Persons entering the ground alone need to be above the age of 14.
  - 21.2 Persons entering the ground who are of the age of 14 or under, need to be accompanied by persons who are at least 16 years of age.
- 22. Entry to the Ground signifies your consent to use of your actual or simulated likeness in connection with the production, exhibition, advertising or exploitation of any audio/video recording of the Match or any external media outlet.
- 23. The Club reserves the right to eject any person failing to comply with any of the Ground Regulations or whose presence within the Ground is reasonably be construed as constituting a source of danger, nuisance or annoyance to any other person. This could lead to further action by the Club including, but not limited to, the withdrawal of any season ticket (without reimbursement) and other benefits.
