

VIVIANNE MIEDEMA FORWARD



Since joining the club, from Bayern Munich in 2017, Vivianne has proved herself to be one of the best players in the world. She quickly settled into North London life. In the 2018/19 season she set a new record of 22 goals in 20 WSL matches. She also gave 10 assists and was named the PFA Player of the Year.

Vivianne scores goals and breaks records everywhere. She was the top scorer in the Champions League in 2016/17 while still at Munich. For Arsenal, she scored four goals in one Champions League game, against Slavia Prague in October 2019. Incredibly, two months later she scored six and made four assists in a record 11-1 WSL victory over Bristol

City. After 70 minutes and with Arsenal 10-0 up, Vivianne was substituted having been involved in every goal!

She is a star on the international scene too. At the 2017 European Championship Vivianne scored in the semi-final and then twice in the final to help the Netherlands win the trophy. In the summer of 2019, Vivianne reached the World Cup final, becoming the Netherlands all-time leading goalscorer in the process. She has now scored more goals for the Dutch team than anyone in the history of men's or women's football.

Miedema's technical ability is outstanding; her precision and control make her one of the most watchable players around. Her style of play has been compared to Dutch footballing legends Dennis Bergkamp and Marco Van Basten. She is another ice-cold finisher. She doesn't over celebrate her goals; she just gets on with her job and focuses on the next chance!

Fortunately for Arsenal, the stylish and clinical striker is a young player and still has many years ahead of her. We can't wait to see how much more Vivianne can win and achieve in the game.
