THE CHALLENGE: To write a **newspaper report** on the match. Give all the details of the game using all the writing techniques and features of a newspaper article. Try to include:

- A **headline**
- The **5 Ws** (Who? What? Where? When? and Why?)
- **Name** of the reporter
- Write in **third person** and use the past tense
- A **photo/drawing** with a caption
