
# MEADOW PARK

COVID-19 SUPPORTER CODE OF CONDUCT



#### A MESSAGE FROM BWFC COVID OFFICER MEGAN REID

Dear Supporter,

We are extremely excited to welcome supporters back at Meadow Park again!

However, in light of the circumstances we find ourselves in and to ensure your experience at Meadow Park is safe and enjoyable, you must follow the guidelines outlined in this Supporter COVID-19 Code of Conduct.

Strict zones and protocols are in place to create a safe environment for all within the ground.

Local and national UK Government advice should be followed with regards to mixing households and travelling between areas in different tiers. By purchasing a match day ticket, you accept to follow the ground regulations, as well as the additional COVID-19 measures that have been put in place to mitigate risk and help to protect you as supporters, as well as players, management and other staff.

Failure to comply with this COVID-19 code of conduct may jeopardise public health. Noncompliance will be taken seriously and may result in disciplinary sanctions which may lead to expulsion from Meadow Park.

Megan Reid COVID Officer Boreham Wood FC To ensure your safety and the safety of all attending the stadium, you must adhere to the following key points: -

- If you are feeling unwell or display any potential symptoms of COVID-19 you must not attend
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 or have been in contact with a positive case in the 14 days prior to the event, you must not attend
- If you test positive for COVID-19 in the 14 days after attending the match, you must inform the Club at the earliest opportunity by emailing Boreham Wood FC COVID Officer Megan Reid megan.reid@covidbwfc.com
- If you are self-isolating or in quarantine after returning from a country on the quarantine list, you must not attend
- Please bring and wear a face mask or face covering at all times. Only exceptions include medically exempt, whilst eating or drinking, or for children under 11
- Please ensure social distancing at all times
- Please keep movement within the stadium to a minimum to limit potential contact points and prevent congregation
- Please follow current UK Government guidance on non-household interaction at all times
- Please sanitise and/or wash hands at regular intervals when within the stadium, specifically on entry and exit of Meadow Park
- Please be aware you may be temperature checked upon entry into Meadow Park and may have to show ID.

#### ENTRY

- Please have your ticket ready for inspection upon entering the Stadium. ID may be checked, and normal ground regulations apply
- All tickets are non-transferrable. Please be aware BWFC are required to keep attendees contact details for 21 days to assist track and trace
- Please make yourself aware of your route to/from the Stadium before attending the event, including gate and arrivals times, as this may have changed since your last visit
- Please arrive in good time to go through the necessary entry procedures
- Be aware that non-invasive temperature checks may take place. If a supporter's temperature is found to be 37.8C or above on two occasions, then you will be refused entry, told to return home immediately and book a COVID-19 test
- Please bring and wear a face mask or face covering at all times
- Please maintain social distancing at all times
- Where possible please avoid using your hands to turn the turnstiles
- Please sanitise your hands upon entry into the Stadium using the hand sanitiser provided.

## DURING THE MATCH

- Please follow signage and adhere to steward's instructions
- Please bring and wear a face mask or face covering at all times
- Please maintain social distancing at all times
- Please do not lean over the pitch perimeter fence
- Please try to avoid all unnecessary touching of surfaces, your face, eyes or mouth whilst within the stadium
- Please sanitise your hands whilst within the Stadium using the hand sanitiser provided
- Spectators should remain in seats during the match (where applicable) and where possible avoid any face-to-face contact whilst navigating within the stadium
- Please only sit in your allocated seat or in the allocated standing area, and avoid close contact with anyone who are not within your household or bubble
- Please refrain from throwing the ball directly back on to the pitch. A ball boy and/or steward should be passed the ball to be sanitised before it is returned onto the pitch
- Extreme care should be taken when shouting, celebrating or singing
- Priority will be given to people ascending the stairs and a keep left policy should always operate throughout the stadium with strict social distancing procedures in place
- Please observe respiratory etiquette. If coughing or sneezing, please do so into a tissue and dispose of immediately before sanitising hands
- When using Stadium toilets, please follow signage, practice good hygiene and follow the steward's instructions. Strict social distancing must be followed in these areas
- Stadium catering is available within Meadow Park.
  We politely remind all supporters to use these facilities throughout the match and not just at half time to limit queues forming
- Spectators bringing children are responsible for always supervising them.

### **EXIT**

- Please follow signage and adhere to steward's instructions
- Please wear a face mask or face covering at all times
- Please maintain social distancing at all times
- To keep supporters safe and allow for social distancing you may be held briefly after the match to allow for a staggered exit from the stadium
- Where possible, please remain in your allocated area until crowds around you have dispersed before exiting.
