

COVID-19 Information - Stadium Events & Functions September 2021

Arsenal Football Club are looking forward to welcoming events back to the Emirates Stadium. The safety and wellbeing of our attendees and staff is our priority. To support this, as an organiser or attendee of an event, you must follow these instructions and any others provided to you by the Club or a member of staff.

Transport and Arrival

In line with government guidance, we are advising all visitors to follow the government's [Safer Travel guidance](#) when travelling to an event.

Prior to attending an event

We advise all visitors to take a COVID-19 Lateral Flow Test 48 hours before the event.

You must not attend if you or a member of your household or support bubble has any of the following symptoms:

- **A high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- **A new and/or continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Or

If you have received a positive COVID-19 test result less than 10 days before the event

Or

If you or any member of your household or support bubble are required to quarantine having recently visited a country on the red, amber or green lists. See [Government Guidance for entering England](#)

Or

If you or a member of your household or support bubble has tested positive for Covid-19

Or

If you or a member of your household or support bubble has been advised to isolate by NHS test and trace or the PHE local health protection team

Other

These instructions may be updated from time to time based on new Government guidance and/or Club policies.
